Sir,

With reference to your despatch No. 201 of the 27th of June, I have the honour to inform you that I am in accord with the opinion expressed that remissions granted in the Nyasaland Protectorate on account of service in this country should be reimbursed by this Protectorate and I shall be prepared to authorise provision in the Estimates for that purpose when received.

2. With reference to the final paragraph of your despatch I regret that it was not stated that the Officer Commanding Troops concurs in my view. The instruction has, however, been carefully noted for future compliance.
