With reference to your telegram of the 22nd ult<sup>imo</sup> <sup>\*</sup> respecting certain alterations and additions to the European Hospital at Nairobi, I have the honour to inform you that the works mentioned in the Memorandum of the 30th of May from the Acting Director of Public Works, which formed an enclosure to my despatch No. 724 of the 19th of September, <sup>†</sup> have been carried out with the following exceptions:-

- (a) Sunblind to Operating Theatre
- (b) Brackets for Charts
- (c) Curtain rods to two ward windows.

These services will, however, be completed during the present financial year.

2. The Principal Medical Officer has been asked to confer with Professor Simpson regarding hospital arrangements and septic tanks, and I will in due course communicate further with you on the matter.
