Sir:-

I am directed by Secretary Sir E. Grey to acknowledge
the receipt of your letter, No. 2656 of the 29th, ultimo,
respecting the proposed appointment of a surveyor at
Zanzibar, and to thank you for the assistance given by
your Department in the matter.

In view of the amounts of the salaries paid in East
Africa Sir E. Grey considers that a salary of Three Hundred
pounds a year would be sufficient for the officer selected.
He would also receive a travelling allowance on the scale
laid down by the Zanzibar regulations, and would be provided
by the Government with quarters or with an allowance in
lieu thereof. A copy of the regulations, to which the
officer would be subject in so far as they apply to
temporary employment, is enclosed herewith.

Sir E. Grey would be much obliged if Mr. Secretary
Harcourt would consult the Governor of the East Africa
