These figures show an excess of £ 510 over the figures submitted to the Treasury. This is due to £ 1500 being inserted for Fuel benefit, Cadet's Branch whereas from the Budget (1/19 of 4/40) it appeared that only £ 700 was to be added to other items viz £ 500 for Fuel & £ 200 for Cadet's Branch. In fact in 1905-07 there is £ 870.

Except for the £ 400 of the Fuel benefit which the figures submitted to the Treasury and I have put in the deficit in the other copy of the estimate.

The Budget and Revenue Committee in their report of £ 1500 voted therein was only for the Budget, whereas it actually provided also for
