No. 44. My telegram 8th March, Lenana left dying  
injunctions to his people (to) obey Government and  
Northern Masai with their cattle to move Southern  
reserve asked that Government take <sup>care</sup> of children.  
It is possible that these wishes being expressed in  
the presence of several witnesses made good im-  
pression on Northern Masai and are indicative of  
honesty of Lenana's demand for reamalgamation of the  
tribe. He appointed as successor his son boy fifteen  
years, regent will be appointed during minority.
