I have struck out the whole list of
Orders put in force during the year -
If in any policy legislation is passed
during the year under review which
is of special interest, it is a good thing
right that the Ord. should be mentioned
with a few explanatory words.

But a list - such as the one herein - can
serve no useful purpose.

Tables appendices are contrary to the instructions
in the Circular of 20 April 1958; but in the present
case there are not many statistical tables in
the body of the Report, & the appendices are
not long in proportion to the Report, were
formidable. I would leave them.

The Report itself is longer than I am from most
Colonies, but East Africa engages public attention more
than most Colonies & Protectorates, & I note that Mr. Butler
