Sir,

I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Fiddes' letter of the 22nd ultimo (4272/1911) enclosing copy of correspondence relating to a proposal made by the Officer Administering the Government of the East Africa Protectorate that rewards should be given to Customs Officials who have prevented losses to the Revenue.

In reply I am to state that My Lords concur in Mr. Secretary Harcourt's proposal to sanction, in the particular case in question, the grant of the awards suggested by Mr. Jackson in the 5th paragraph of his despatch of the 21st of December, and to inform the Governor that, if he thinks fit, he may submit rules for future guidance, on the lines of those indicated in the letter from the Board of Customs of the 9th of February.
