RESOLUTION PASSED BY THE COMMITTEEof theANTI-SLAVERY AND ABORIGINES PROTECTION SOCIETY.

The Committee of the Anti-Slavery and Aborigines Protection Society desires to express its high appreciation of the action of the Secretary of State for the Colonies in ordering the deportation of Mr. Galbraith Cole from British East Africa for exciting race enmity in that Colony. The Committee, convinced that the wanton disregard of native human life shown by a settler in the position of Mr. Cole renders proper relations between the white and black races impossible, and considering that the verdict of acquittal given by the jury at his trial is calculated seriously to affect the natives' regard for law and to bring the administration of justice into disrepute, records its satisfaction that His Majesty's Government has taken this means of marking its sense of the gravity of the offence and of the weighty issues involved.
