To the Secretary of State for the Colonies

Sir

I have the honor to place before you a statement of particulars of the death of my husband, Colin Campbell Bonney, late Major, 5th Bengal Cavalry. His last illness through an accident, while in the execution of his duty. He was in Government Service in Southern East Africa, in the Veterinary Dept, & was in charge of cattle in the Fort Hall District. Some diseases are numerous, some endangering the safety of the cattle - in setting a snare trap to destroy them, it accidentally went off the bell passing through his back, & causing such serious injury as to necessitate the amputation of his leg - he died on Feb. 20th of this year, after three months of terrible suffering - he also served in the P. W. Dept & I have letters from Mr. Watts then Commissioner of Works, others, speaking highly of his work.
