In further reference to our letter of the 5th instant, we beg to inform you that a case has been placed before Sir Edward Carson, K.C., M.P., and Mr. William Rowland, and they have given their opinion thereon.

In view of this joint opinion, we last evening sent the following cable to Sir Percy Girouard, K.C.M.G., Governor of the West Africa Protectorate:-

"As Solicitors Cole obtained Sir Edward Carson's
"Opinion that Order Deportation be opposed on ground
"of illegality ultra vires have notified Colonial
"Office and advised Cole remain in Protectorate.
