



Sir,

Half-yearly Returns for Six
Months ending Dec. 31st. 1911.

I have the honour to forward herewith my usual
Six monthly Returns for the six months ending Dec. 31st. 1911.

At the end of June last we had some 887 applica-
tions pending. During the six months under review we
have had 184 new applications registered, making a total
of 871 to be dealt with. In the same period we have
registered 228 completed deeds, compared with 158 the
previous six months. A further 24 applications have
been cancelled or withdrawn, making the total remaining
828 against 887 for previous six months.

A glance at the detailed analysis will shew
that a large number of the uncompleted deeds come under
the heads "Pending return of draft deeds" (8), "Pending
engrossment" (10), "Pending return of counterpart deeds or
money" (32), "Pending registration" (88), or a total of 140
out of the 828 which have very nearly reached the final
stage, thus leaving 188 as the subject of further remarks.
The two large items "Pending negotiations" (101) and "Pend-
ing surveys" (62), totalling 163, leave only 30 out of the
188 under other heads. This number I consider normal
and satisfactory, and do not therefore propose to allude
to them further in detail.

Regarding the large item "Pending negotiations",
Mr. Campbell, while acting for me, states in the last Return
that the majority of the cases under this heading have been
included in past Returns, and that a large proportion,

especially those on the Coast, where complications in respect of Native Claims and Titles defeat immediate settlement, are likely to keep this item high for some time. The other cause, as stated by Mr.Campbell, contributing largely to this item, is the question of the Massai removal.

Therefore, it will be seen, that causes beyond the control of this Office are responsible for a very large proportion of an item which, without this explanation, might reasonably be the subject, if not of criticism, of question.

With regard to "Pending surveys", Mr.Campbell says in his report that he regrets the improvement shewn in previous six months, when the figure for June 30 to Dec.31. 1910 was reduced to 67 as compared with 112 for the six months previous. It must be remembered, however, that there must always be a certain number of applications pending under this head, especially as long as Missions exist, and that if 112 was decreased in six months

to 67, it must not be thought that it will be reduced in the next six months by the same amount: if the number under this head became 80, I think it would be normal and reasonable.

I do not look upon the cases "Pending registration and return of deeds" as of the same importance; and here, as I have explained in previous reports, we are dependant on the vagaries of a capricious and unbusiness-like public and the delays are beyond our powers of control. I would only say by a process of mathematical deduction that the normal number we might have expected pending if the public had complied with their obligations would have been about 84 instead of 140. I append as usual a table shewing for a period of three years position as regards removal of applications placed under the nebulous heading "Pending negotiations" to the other more or less concrete stages recorded in the analysis. This table has, to my mind, interest, inasmuch as a perusal shews that new applications are being steadily coped with, and the recurring figure only varies within small limits, and is due, as has been explained elsewhere, chiefly to old applications which cannot be dealt with for reasons beyond our control.

In conclusion I would say that I consider the record is on the whole distinctly satisfactory. Not only has progress been shewn, but the figures under all heads for which Government is responsible are becoming normal. In the two cases "Pending negotiations" and "Pending survey", where improvement has still to be looked for,

looked for, good reasons can be given, and although under the former heading I cannot hold out hopes of improvement in the near future, I think the next six months will shew ~~material~~ improvement in the only other item deserving criticism or attention.

 1911 together with a copy of a memorandum
 by the Land Officer.

2. I observe that the ~~Sixth~~ Avenue

Syndicate have been granted leases of 10
 township plots in Nairobi at a rental of
 £150 per annum for each plot. I presume
 that the plots were sold by auction in
 the usual manner, and, if so, I shall be
 glad to be informed of the sum paid in
 each case for the right to lease. In

the case of township plots, the auction price at which the right to lease is sold should be included in the Land Returns as well as the rental payable in respect of the plot, in order that the Returns may furnish a complete record of the consideration received by Government for all Crown Lands alienated.

Further, it appears desirable to impose some limit on the acquisition by individuals or syndicate of large blocks of land in townships presumably for speculation purposes and I shall be glad to receive your observations as to the best means of effecting this object.

3. In the list of land grants in the Naivasha Province I notice that Messrs Newland & McCall have been granted

1,000 acres of agricultural land freehold. In this instance, I presume that the right to purchase the freehold was one of the conditions of the original lease.

In all such cases it should be stated in the Land Returns that the freehold is granted under the terms of the original lease.
