



MEMORANDUM.

THE PROBATE AND ADMINISTRATION (PUBLIC TRUSTEE)
ORDINANCE, 1912.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to enable the Public Trustee appointed under the Public Trustee Act (6 Edw. 7 Ch. 55) to obtain letters of administration without giving the bond which is required of an ordinary Administrator.

Apart from this Ordinance the Courts have no legal authority to exempt the Public Trustee from the obligations imposed by law on an Administrator to give a bond for the proper performance of his duties.

The Ordinance has been passed on the recommendations of the Secretary of State and can be assented to and published.
