Sir,

With reference to your despatch No. 44 of the 24th January, 1912, I have the honour to inform you that the following two clauses covering the questions of leave and contribution to the Provident Fund have been suggested for inclusion in the agreements for mechanics and clerks on the Uganda Railway.

CLAUSE 19

The person engaged shall become a depositor in the Provident Fund for non-pensionable servants of State Railways in the East Africa Protectorate.

CLAUSE 20

The person engaged shall be eligible for leave of absence in accordance with the leave rules in force on the Uganda Railway which are applicable to Railway servants holding similar positions to the person engaged.

Existing clause 19 of the agreement will then become clause 21.
