In reply to your letter of Jan. 20th. I send you my letter of Oct. 19th to the Land Office so you misinterpreted.

The information I received respecting land available in Kenya I received during a personal interview at the Immigrants Information Office last June. The only correspondence I hold on the subject was on the occasion of my first application for information to the Immigrant Information Office. In reply, I received their book of "General Information as to East African" dated 1911, with the remark that as far as they knew, the land laws then existing at Nairobi were much as stated in this book. I now that a certain number of farms were ready for allotment to applicants.

I went at once to the Immigrants Information Office and there received a copy which I mentioned in my letter of Oct. 19th. This is the reason and the reason of my letter of Oct. 19th.
