2. It is anticipated that an appreciable amount will accumulate in this way, as the contemplated works will not in all probability be completed for some time, and it would appear to be equitable that any such accretions should be added to the total available, it being of course understood that they are only utilized in accordance with the general principles governing expenditure of this kind previously recognized and approved.
