No. 120. Your Lordship's telegram of 23rd August proposed arrangement for two days Mombasa visit to Malindi by "Juba" inspection of rubber and fibre plantations Vol three days Nairobi halts for a few hours Malvaaha Stock Farm Nakuru and Delamere's Njoro property arrive at Kisumu on morning of departure of steamer. This will leave about seven days for tour from Nairobi which might be through white settlements with a visit to Thika river seeing the best of country on the way to Fort Hall or combining this with visit to Fort Hall. This would be scarcely proper time for visit to Kenya forest and it would entail sacrifice elsewhere. Despatch follows by mail.
