My Lord,

It has recently been brought to my notice by the Inspector General of Police that in cases of suicide by poison or of sudden death where the use of poison is suspected, the services of an analyst are very much required and further that in instances of this kind, in the absence of an analyst, the courts besides the true cause of death, the Police are frequently placed at a serious disadvantage.

The Medical Department has no one at present capable of examining human remains and I have therefore the honour to submit for Your Lordship's favourable consideration that provision should be made in the ensuing estimates for the appointment of a Government Analyst.
