In connection with the terms of this proposed  
Concession, we would call your attention to the form of  
agreement enclosed in Lt. Col. J. Hayes Sadler's letter  
to Mr. Lyttelton of the 20th. October 1906 which was  
submitted to us in reference to the granting of the Lease  
of the Mabira Forest in Uganda. This form of Agreement  
contains numerous special provisions respecting obtaining  
rubber, for keeping the area of the forest reserved by  
planting and other special provisions incidental to the  
rubber industry. Such of these provisions as we  
considered necessary, were introduced by us in the  
Concession granted to the Mabira Forest (Uganda) Rubber  
Co. Ltd. and we shall be glad to know whether it is desired  
that similar provisions should be introduced into this  
Concession as regards the rubber industry, which the  
Concessionaires propose to carry on, not as in the case of  
as the principle undertaking of that Company  
the Mabira Company, but as we understand, as one of the  
subsidiary objects for which the proposed Company is to be  
formed to work.
