Gentlemen.

I have the honour to acknowledge your memorandum of 15th August (which as I have been travelling only reached me yesterday) and the Form of Agreement successed with it, which I now return.

I observe that the agreement is substantially the same as my present agreement, and that it holds forward no prospect of increment; nor of permanent employment; nor of a pension; but rather indicates that at the end of three syears another agreement will be proposed for a further three years' service, on similar terms, until the time comes for me to resign, when I shall be in a somewhat worse position as remarks prospects than when I entered the service.

It is my subtition to rise in the service and to become a permanent official, but the draft agreement you have submitted for my consideration, represents the service to be so precurious as a permanent profession, that I beg to request that I may be given a short time to consider the matter. I observe that the date at which I am required under my agreement to state whether I desire to renew my present service or not, is let January.

In the above circumstances I have the honour to request that I may be given an opportunity either in interview

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or by private letter, of forming a just opinion of that properts the service offers to men who, like myself, streetly desire to make it their profession.

I do not think that I can describe more clearly than I have done in my letter to you of the 28th what are reasons for the hesitation I feel in accepting the agreement which you sent for my consideration, but I should like to add to that letter by stating the conditions under which I should not feel that hesitation.

- That the agreement should offer such conditions of permanent employment as would offer encouragement to making the service a profession.
- 2. That the minimum rate of increment should be stated.
- That my service should entitle me to such a pension as is usually expected by those engaged under a salary in the Tropics.
