
I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Anrobus's letter of the 22nd instant (10142/1907), respecting the case of Mr. Kharsheji Naservanji, whom it is proposed to retire from the office of Superintendent in the Public Works Department of the East Africa Protectorate as under the provisions of section 2 of the Superannuation Act, 1887.

In reply I am to request you to inform the Earl of Elgin, that, on the assumption that Mr. Naservanji continues in the service of the Protectorate till 16th April next, My Lords assent to the grant to him of a pension of £95.6.8 from East African funds. Should he have retired before that date, he will only be qualified for a pension of £86.13.4.
