Sir,

I have laid before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Anstey's letter of the 1st instant (13875/1907) further respecting the purchase of a large engine at Nairobi in the East Africa Protectorate.

In reply I am to request you to inform the Earl of Elgin that My Lords sanction

- (1) the provision by the Government of a site on which to house the engine, and
- (2) a contribution of 5,000 Rupees from Protectorate funds towards the cost of a building for the purpose (to be met out of savings on the gross authorised expenditure for the current financial year).
