It would be as well to say that copies of the pamphlet can be obtained from Messrs Wyman, etc., although I fear that advertising the same will not be of much practical use, as the pamphlet, whilst giving some idea of the size of the forests and the conditions prevailing in various districts, does not give a definite idea of the character of the wood, and it would be as well, if possible, to procure some samples to interest the trade. Samples of some of these woods mentioned have been submitted to me in the ordinary course of business, and we should be glad if they might profitably be exploited if it were found possible to get the companies to take up leases, but to do this it would of course

necessary for the Government to offer concessions, and state the terms which the leases would be issued.

If there are any other points on which you wish information I will be only too pleased to do my best to be of service to you.
