

In reply to Mr. Leake's letter (25594/1907) of the 20th instant I am to request you to inform the Earl of Elgin that the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury concur in the proposal that an excess of £3,375 which is likely to be required over the provision of £10,000 for New Minor Works in the Uganda Railway Estimates for the current year should be charged against Capital (Loan) Works, under which head more than equivalent savings are available.

I am to enquire when it is anticipated that the least expenditure account in respect of works for which no account has been provided under the Uganda Railway Acts can finally be closed.
