Sir,

I am to request you to inform the Earl of Elgin that, in the circumstances represented in Mr. Just's letter of the 15th instant (28573/1907), the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury assent to the reduction of the staff of the King's African Rifles Pay Department by one Paymaster and 1 Clerk and the appointment of the two officers in question to be Paymaster and Paymaster's Clerk respectively in the Police Department of the East Africa Protectorate.

My Lords note that the proposal involves no additional charge on Protectorate funds.

I am however to enquire whether, in view of this addition to the staff of the Police Department, it will not be possible to effect any savings in the expenditure on the Department in other directions.
