Sir,

In reply to Mr. Antrebus' letter (33091/1907) of the 19th ultimo I am to request you to inform the Earl of Elgin that the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury think it would be most convenient that the special "remanet expenditure" referred to should be shown as follows in the Estimates of the East Africa Protectorate for 1908/9.

I. These should be annexed to the Estimates a separate statement showing the position of the four services in question under the heads specified in the following form, viz.

II. The expenditure on these services should be embodied in the "statement, partly estimated, of assets and liabilities on 31st March 1908" (corresponding to Appendix B. of the current Estimates), in one of two ways. Either the actual estimated expenditure to 31st March 1908 (column (3) of the table above), alone, should appear among the liabilities, or the total sanctioned expenditure for 1907/8 (column (1) of the table) should appear among the liabilities, the remanet expenditure i.e. the amount by which the actual expenditure is expected to fall short of the sanctioned expenditure, (column (4)), being entered under the assets.

III. This statement of assets and liabilities at 31st March 1908 should be supplemented by a statement similar to Appendix C (B) of the current year's Estimate, in which the remanet expenditure (i.e. the balance to be revoted) should appear as a charge against, or a deduction from the estimated balance on 31st March 1908.
