Sir,

We beg to acknowledge yours of 6th inst. for which we are obliged.

We feel sure however that there is some error as to the area for which the 10,000 acres near Saveta has been substituted if such is the case. You will remember that in consideration of growing up 4000 acres at "Muhorom" we were promised 10,000 acres at "Bura" + 10,000 acres at "Mabundu". The latter we have never had granted to us & probably the Saveta Land is in place of this. We have about 600 acres under cultivation at Bura 500 acres of which is Cotton & we are now ploughing & seeding 1000 acres with Cotton outside of cereals. We also have buildings & machinery at Bura & are

about to send out more machinery at all.  
It is quite evident therefore that we could not  
have agreed to such a substitution & that  
the Land Office has made an error in  
the name of the locality.

We do not feel much obliged if you  
would kindly send another cable to clear  
up this matter unless your your cable of  
March 1906 will enable you to do so.

We of course shall be glad to send  
you a cheque for the cost of the cables in return  
as you advise us of the amount.
