Sir,

With reference to your letter
No. 33383 of the 28th September last;
I have the honor to lay before you
the following considerations with
regard to Lord Elgin's ruling
informing me that - "his Lordship
has not been able to approve of
the payment of the fees for the
course from Government funds, or
of any lodging or other allowance
in respect of it."

1. My Deputy, Mr Broadbent, had
his post-graduate class fees paid from
Government funds.

2. The special leave granted me
to enable me to visit the South
African Colonies was not leave of
absence but was for the purpose of
an official visit to consult with
the Veterinarians of these Colonies
so as to assist me in my
work in East Africa and I have
already had the honor to forward

to the Secretary of State for the Colonies, you
Dorothy Pickett.

You are official account of my
visit.

3. Since my return to England
the most of my time has been
occupied in veterinary & practical
and scientific investigations, and
as you are undoubtedly aware I was
for three weeks in Chelsea on
Lord Palmerston's estate carrying
out experiments with regard to
African red water, and at present
I am working in the Board
of Agriculture Laboratory where
I have been since the
beginning of November.

You will therefore see that
my holiday - far as has been
practically taken up with
veterinary work which I trust will
be of benefit to the East-
African Settlement.

The English and Irish
veterinarians in London have
experienced me considerable personal
difficulties and I therefore trust that
the matter will receive your kind
& favourable consideration.
