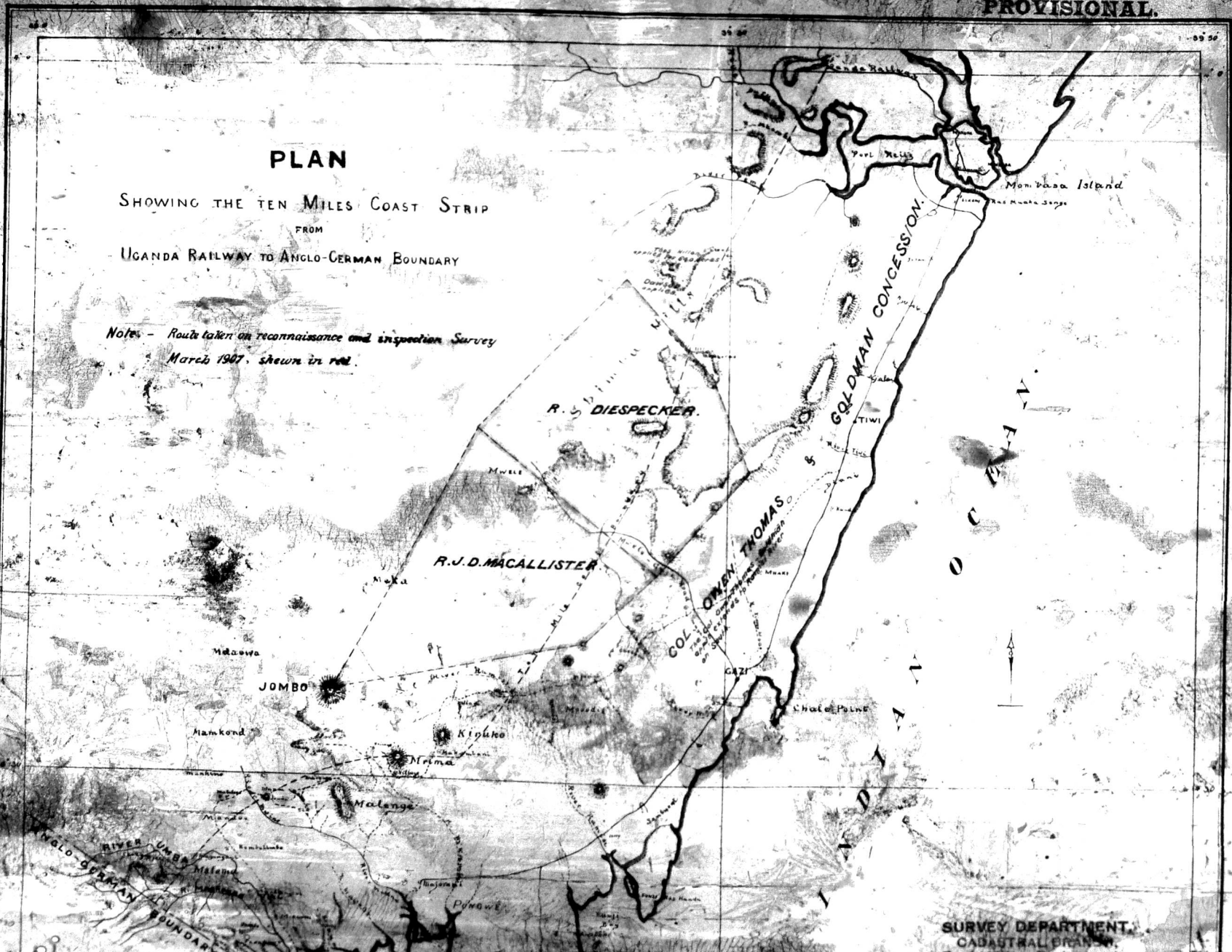

March 1907, shown in red.*



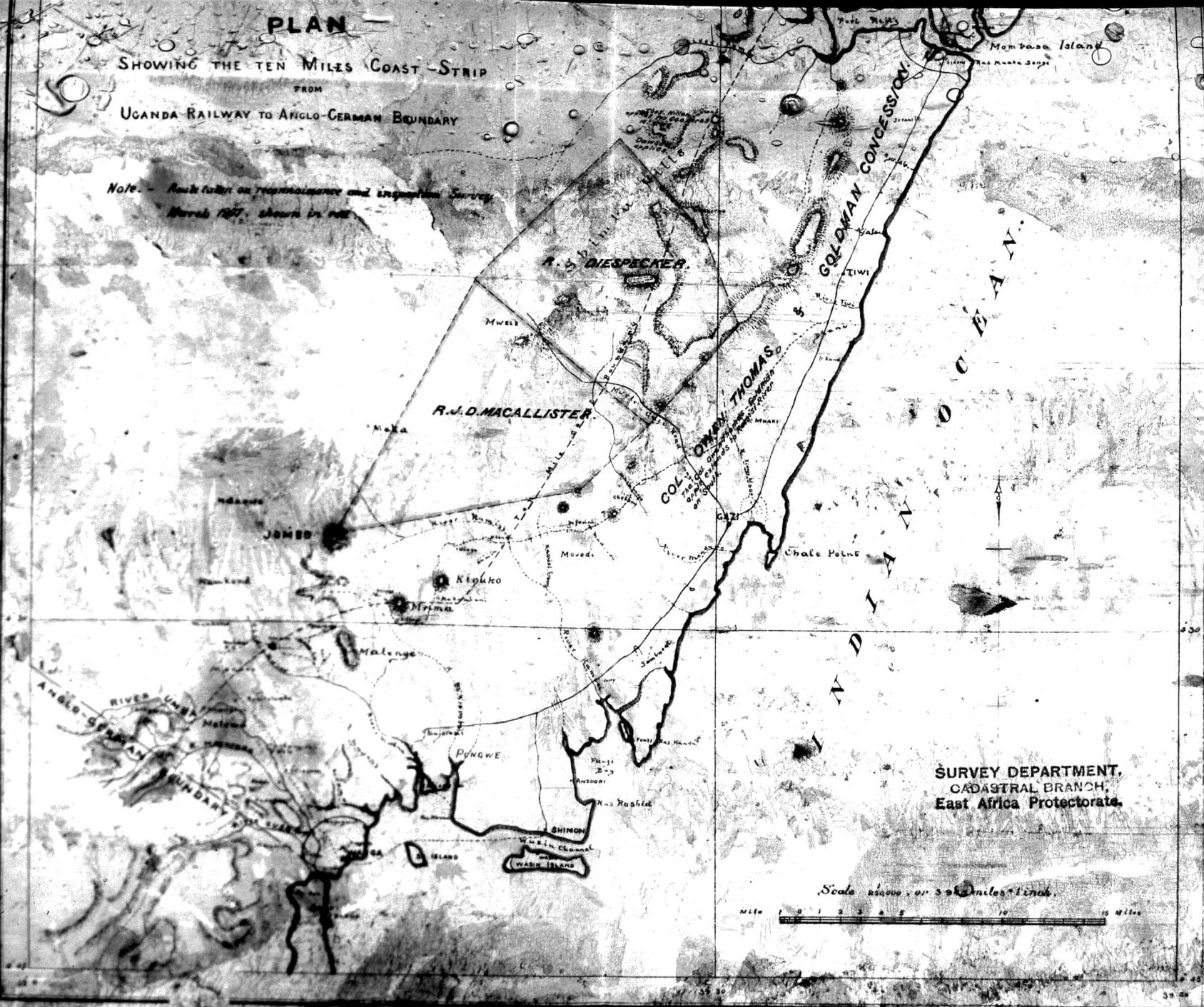
