My Lord,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of Lord Evelyn's despatch No. 156 of the 2nd ultimo sanctioning the re-allocation of £2,000 provided for the construction of a new station at Voi, for the work of erecting Police lines at Lamu.

B. Subsequently, however, to the date of my communication on the subject His Lordship in a telegram dated March 18th intimated his wish that the cost of the operations against the Kisi should be a charge on the general revenues of the Protectorate. All savings will, consequently, be required for this purpose and I have been obliged to countermand my previous instructions regarding the Lamu Police Lines.
