TELEGRAM. The Governor of the East African Protectorate to the

Secretary of State for the Colonies.

(Received Colonial Office 9:00 A.M. 8th May, 1908.)

No. 64. Patterson informs me that Blyth died on morning of 21st March at Laramis 35 miles from Marnabit (??where he) accidentally shot himself in the head with a revolver. Death immediate. He had been ill for two days. Mr. Blyth Patterson had been with him all night accident (ally) occurred early in the morning whilst temporarily alone. Patterson returned very ill. Statements will be sent by post. Hopwood with us Mrs. Blyth comes to-day both leave for England on "Hercog".
