My Lord,

I have the honour to report that on the 10th March last I sanctioned the temporary employment of Corporal A. Claiden, of the Police, as Warder in the Mombasa Prison.

2. Corporal Claiden, who served in the European detachment of the Police from June 1st to July 15th 1907 as a Constable, and from 15th July to March 9th 1908 as Corporal, would have been recommended for promotion to Sergeant had he not been transferred to the Prison Department.

3. His work has been very favourably reported on by the Superintendent of the Prison, and as he himself is anxious for permanent employment in this capacity, I have sanctioned his appointment as Warder on a salary of £120/- per annum plus £40/- messing allowance. I trust that my action will meet with Your Lordship's approval.
