No.117. 17th June. 2nd Lieutenants Olaf Hansen of Aalesund, Norway, Carl Johansen of Orrebro, Sweden, and Axel Anderson of Hellerga, Sweden, Congo officials from Mmahaji are here out of funds. They refuse to return to Congo where they say that they have been kept for months without salary food or medicine. All have medical certificates from our Medical Department and medical officer here recommends return home. Two are ill. If Government of Congo Free State continue to refuse passages, please communicate with their Government. Belgian Consul here cannot take action.
