Sir,

I have the honour to inform you that H.M. will not be advised to exercise his powers of disallowance with respect to Ordinance no. 4 of 1908 of the Legislature of the E.A.P. entitled "An Ordinance to apply a sum of money for the service of the year ending the 31st day of March 1909", a copy of which accompanied your despatch no. 266 of the 13th June.

This Ordinance does not contain the provision usual in such enactments making the Governor's warrant the authority for the payment out of the sums specified in the Ordinance. I enclose for your info. a copy of the Appropriation Ordinance of the Colony of Sierra Leone, and I shall be glad if a provision similar to that of sec. 4 of this Ordinance may be embodied in future similar enactments in the E.A.P.
