No. 215. Your Lordship's telegram of 14th October. Carefully considered question referred to during tour in farming area with Director of Agriculture. Twenty times rent is sufficient for development and consider inexpedient to demand more. If forty times rent insisted on then branded stock for two years in possession should count towards half development but the lesser rate is preferable. I deprecate exemptions being made for any class. Question possible work to be put in by Soers was considered and not admitted before my despatch No. 449 was written. Despatch follows by mail.
