To reply to Your Lordship's despatch No. 860 of
September 2nd relating to a request by Mr. J.A. Simson for an
increase of salary - I have the honour to report that, after
consulting with my legal advisers, I consider that it would be
not in the interest of my Government to grant to Mr. Simson's
case hard though it may be for other officials and would not
in itself justify an increase of salary. The largely
increased cost of living in South Africa, however, is a
sufficient reason for a favourable consideration of his
request and I have the honour to recommend that it be
granted an additional £100 per annum to his present salary.
