Sir,

In reply to Mr. Antrobus' letter (5768/1908) of the 26th ultimo, I am to request you to inform the Earl of Elgin that the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury offer no objection to the proposals of the Governor of the East Africa Protectorate as regards the treatment of survey fees, viz: that the fees shall be passed through a deposit account, from which the payments will be made to licensed surveyors, while the fees paid in respect of property surveyed by Government staff will be credited ultimately to revenue.

I am to enquire whether a small additional fee (which would accrue to Government) could be levied in cases in which an application is cancelled, or in which the survey is made by licensed surveyors. As My Lords understand it, under the present system, Government receives no payment in respect of the expense to which it is put in these cases.
