In reply to Mr. Antrobus' letter (5768/1908) of the 26th ultime, I am to request you to inform the Earl of Elgin that the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Transpay offer no objection to the proposals of the Commissioner of Give East Africa Proceedings as 75% and the treatment of survey from rist: that the fees whall be passed through a deposit abrount, from which the pagazines will be made to licensed surveyors, while the fees paid is remost of property surveyed by Government staff will be applied uitinately to revenue.
