OREASURY CHAMBERS

Sir.

I have it before the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Antrobus's letter of the 25th ultimo (19538/1908), renewing the proposal criginally made in 1906 for a reduction in the rate for the carriage of imported sheep on the Uganda Railway.

The Barl of Crewe will be aware that Thear Lordships see general objection to fixing up-rates on the railway at amounts which do not cover the cost of the return haulage of empty trucks (as appears to be proposed in this cost).

On the other hand the import of sheep may be expected to result directly in increased downward traffic in wool. In view of this consideration, as of the position of the railway generally, My Lords will no longer withhold sanction for the reduction of the rate to 5 annas per vehicle mile, (subject to the limits given in the goods tariff as to the number of animals to be loaded on each truck), as a tentative measure, on the understanding that a report will be furnished as to its working after it has been tried for one year.
