Sir,

I have laid before the Lords Commissioners His Majesty's Treasury Mr. Antrobus's letter (38859) of the 20th ultimo further with regard to the salary of Mr. Edmondson, a Veterinary Officer in the East African Protectorate.

In reply I am to say that in view of the fact that the Secretary of State is retaining the office of Mr. Edmondson as a special case the salary of being placed on the pensionable establishment may continue to receive emoluments of £440 per annum. But these emoluments should in future be shown in the Estimates as "Salary £400, personal allowance £40", to make clear that £400 is the normal limit of salary pensionable Veterinary Assistants.
