My Lord,

I have the honour to request the favour of an expression of Your fordship's views in resard to the procedure to be followed in the case of serious filmess or death of unofficial residents in this Protectorate, who have no near relatives with them, and more firsticularly with reference to the despetch of cablegrams to England on their behalf.

- 2. The patients themselves are often not in a condition to authorize the sending of telegrams and, though I presume that the Government cannot be held to be responsible for the supply of information to the relations of persons who are not in its service, we render ourselves liable to a charge of inhumanity if we neglect to advise them.
- are being treated in a Soverment floopital their receives should be informed of their condition in all cases in which a communication walk have been sent, had the patients been afficials. Detrate individuals falling ill or dying under any other aircumstances can scarcely be considered to come within the communication of the Government.
