Protectorate to the Secretary of State for the Colon

If I am required to report on Uganda I request that may receive instructions. It is desirable that I should be at Mombasa in the middle of November and also to have three weeks session of Council, November, December. I sould leave at present, but otherwise it would have to be deferred until December, January.
