Your ltr. 5 Oct. proposes to demonetize 2 anna pieces at same time as aluminium coinage and piece - Do you approve?

W. Read.

The intention was to demonetise the old silver $\frac{1}{8}$ ^{rupees} ~~annas~~ pieces & the copper pie as soon as their replacement by the new nickel-bronze or nickel coins had progressed sufficiently. In the meantime, the coins were kept alive by par. 11 of the East Africa & Uganda (Currency) Ord. in C. 1905, of which I annex a copy, pending the issue of a Proclamation by the Govt. demonetising them. The time for the issue of the Proclamation has apparently now
