The Governor of the East Africa Protectorate to the Secretary of State for the Colonies.

(Received Colonial Office 1.9.p.m. 11th November, 1909).

November 11th. With reference to your cipher telegram of the 4th November accommodation will be provided at Government House for the whole party. I have to request the Crown Agents for the Colonies may be pressed to furnish as soon as the order given for carpets etc. for Government House. At the present moment the House is only partly furnished.
