My Lord,

In reply to Your Lordship's despatch No. 502 of September 24th/1009 respecting the granted land to the Seventh Day Adventist Mission, I have the honour to report that the Mission in question appears to have done little or no work in the Territory and I am prepared to allow it to acquire any further property until I am in possession of additional information as to its aims and bona fides.

I have caused a communication to be addressed to the Mission couched in similar terms to those in which I wrote to the Yemmonite Mission as reported in my despatch No. 505 of October 12nd.
