Sir,

In view of the further explanation furnished in
the enclosures to Mr. Antrobus' letter of the 3rd instant
(4606/1909), I am to request you to inform the Earl of
Crewe that the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's
Treasury sanction the temporary appointment for one year
from 1st April next of Mr. Hirtzel as Factory and Boiler
Inspector in the British East Africa Protectorate. My
Lords will be glad to receive in connection with the
Estimates for 1910-11 a report upon the success of this
arrangement and upon the necessity for its continuance.

I am to suggest however, that Mr. Hirtzel should
not be permitted to give gratuitous advice to private firms
in the Protectorate but that a suitable fee should be
charged upon occasions when he is consulted, and credited
to Protectorate funds.
