## RULES AND REGULATIONS

FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND MANAGEMENT OF THE INSTITUTION AND THE  
FUNDS THEREOF, MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

Revised February, 1885

N.B.—Membership of the Institution is required by the Company of  
all their Servants in India who by the Rules and Regulations  
thereof may from time to time be or become eligible for such  
Membership.

b. The Institution, subject to the general directions and control  
of the Board of Directors of the Company, shall be managed by a  
Committee of five members, to be appointed by the Secretary of  
State, the Agents for the Company, and the Directors of the Company.

6. The subject of any matter shall die or be removed on the ground of such illness or any other cause, and persons appointed (if any) in which case the same shall be settled during the absence of the subject of such matter.

7. In and in respect of each year ending on the 31st day of December in which the net receipts of the Institution shall exceed the gross receipts to pay thereon at the rate of £5 per annum upon the sum of £10,000,000, together with any other sums in addition thereto, which the Secretary of State and the Company may from time to time under the provisions of the Contract between them, dated the 22nd day of December, 1874, agree to enter in the accounts specified in Clauses 24 and 25 thereof, there shall be contributed to the funds of the Institution from and out of such excess of net receipts a sum equal to the aggregate amount of the subscriptions of the Members for each year, or so much thereof as the said excess of net receipts may be sufficient to pay, provided that such contribution shall in no case exceed in amount 1 per cent of the net receipts of the Undertaking.

8. There shall be two Trustees of the funds of the Institution: one of the Trustees shall be an Officer of the Government of India, and shall be appointed by the Secretary of State, and shall be an Officer in the service of the Company, and shall be appointed by the Board of Directors of the Company. Any Trustee appointed by the Secretary of State may at any time be removed by the Secretary of State, and any Trustee appointed by the Board of Directors may at any time be removed by the Board of Directors; and if and whenever any Trustee shall be so removed or shall resign, or die, or become incapable to act, such vacancy, qualified as aforesaid, shall be filled up by the Secretary of State or by the party by whom the Trustee was appointed, as the case may be, and the person so appointed shall be deemed to have been appointed as if he had been originally appointed.

9. The Trustees shall, as soon as two Trustees shall have been appointed as aforesaid, assign and transfer to such Trustees all securities on which they may be entitled to receive any interest, and shall from time to time pay up in a Bank of England or into such other Bank as the Secretary of State shall direct, or to the credit of the Institution, to an account to be approved by the Secretary of State, all moneys received by the Trustees on behalf of the Institution, and all moneys now in the hands of the Trustees belonging to the Institution shall forthwith be paid into such account. All moneys in the credit of that account shall be paid out only by the Trustees, the line being...

it shall be the duty of the Secretary to cause the same to be printed and distributed to all members of the Association.

II. On the 1st day of January next there shall be a meeting of the Association equal to but not exceeding that of the half-year (as determined by the vote of the members on the 15th day of December, 1879) to be held at the City of New York.

1. On account of the salaries of the members, a sum equal to the aggregate of such subscriptions.
2. On account of the salaries of the Secretary and Treasurer, a sum which bears the same proportion to the whole of the said sum of 1 per cent. on the aggregate of the said subscriptions as the aggregate amount of the salaries of the said Secretary and Treasurer bears to the aggregate amount of the salaries of all the members of the Association.

13. In the Committee's opinion, the provisions of a Member are such that the withdrawal of any sum in excess of the sum of credit represented by the Member's contributions, and not exceeding the sum of £50, or the equivalent thereof in Indian currency, may be withdrawn by him temporarily

- (1) To pay for the passage of the Member himself when proceeding to Europe, or a Colony, on medical certificate, or returning after such absence.
- (2) To pay for the passage from or to Europe, or a Colony, of any Member of the family of the said member desiring to visit him in India, or desiring in case of sickness, or other urgent cause, to proceed to Europe or a Colony.
