Sir,

In the circumstances represented in Mr. Antrobus's letter of the 9th March last, (7343/1909), I am to request you to inform the Earl of Crews that the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury sanction the grant of £50 to Mr. D.D. Waller in consideration of his having acted as Superintendent of Government Transport for over six months during the absence of Mr. Wilson, in addition to carrying out his own duties as Protector of Immigrants, the charge in question to be apportioned between the Funds of the Uganda and East Africa Protectorates.

My Lords would suggest, with a view to avoiding unnecessary correspondence, that in future cases of this kind when an officer is unavoidably called upon to perform for a period in excess of three months the duties of a superior owing to the absence of the latter on the public service, the Secretary of State should be at liberty to award such gratuity as he thinks fit without obtaining the previous consent of this Board provided that the cost can be met without involving an increase in the authorized gross expenditure of the year and that the amount of the gratuity in no case exceeds £50 <sup>or</sup> one half of the difference between the two salaries for the period in question, or which ever is less.
