Confirming my conversation with your officers today, and enclosing you copy of assets bank taken on the property, and the great drawback of the bank, has been the want of a paper decontaminating machine, and we think we have it, and the people who control it, are willing to spend £1000 at once to test it, and if satisfactory, think by the tests made here in the presence of his family they can have any reason to believe that the process our friends will provide £1000 to develop working capital and develop the property at once.
