I have not yet replied to your letter of 18th inst. as I had left the matter in Mr. Soukes' hands to arrange. I understand from him that he has come to certain arrangements with regard to the lease and to the minimum amount to be spent on the property, but I have not heard anything definite, or seen him, for over a fortnight. I should esteem it a favour if you would kindly let me know the position of affairs at the present moment, as I have just received a proposal from a factory owner, living in the same locality, to appropriate the 20,000 acres with their property and provide all the working capital necessary.

With regard to paragraph 4 of your letter, I would be glad to hear how the work of 231-2 is arrived at, for I have no recollection of authorising any large expenditure, and your letter was the first intimation I received of the subject.

I trust to be assured with a reply at your earliest convenience.
