The House of Commons will shortly have an opportunity of expressing its opinion of the conduct of certain Magistrates in which that conduct has seen dealt with by the Government.

The object of the pamphlet you will receive with this is to bring together, in convenient form for your perusal, statements of fact and of opinion that have lately appeared in the Prass ty reading these letters you will see that this is no party bestion, but, on the contrary, one that involves the maintenance of our best Colonial traditions.

The gravity of the matter lies in the fact that these instances are not isolated, but are typical of conduct in the identification. They also show that such conduct is in effect condoned by these in authority.

It is an ungrateful task to deal with individual cases, but reque accusations are useless, and so are vague promises of reform.

The Colonial Office having declined to lay the papers before the House, it has leaved necessary to add further information in order to make cless the siroumstances under discussion.

Igno ince cannot now be pleaded. The responsibility rests with the Public, and a cve all with Parliament, for a state of things incompatible ring good government, and which has been confeded." different out far more insidious slavery."
